Celebration of the 77th Republic Day of India in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia

The 77th Republic Day of India was celebrated at the Consulate General of India, Jeddah, with enthusiastic participation from members of the Indian community across the western region of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The celebrations began with a floral tribute to Mahatma Gandhi by senior officials of the Consulate and their families, followed by the unfurling of the Indian National Flag by the Consul General of India, Shri Fahad Ahmed Khan Suri, and the singing of the National Anthem.
